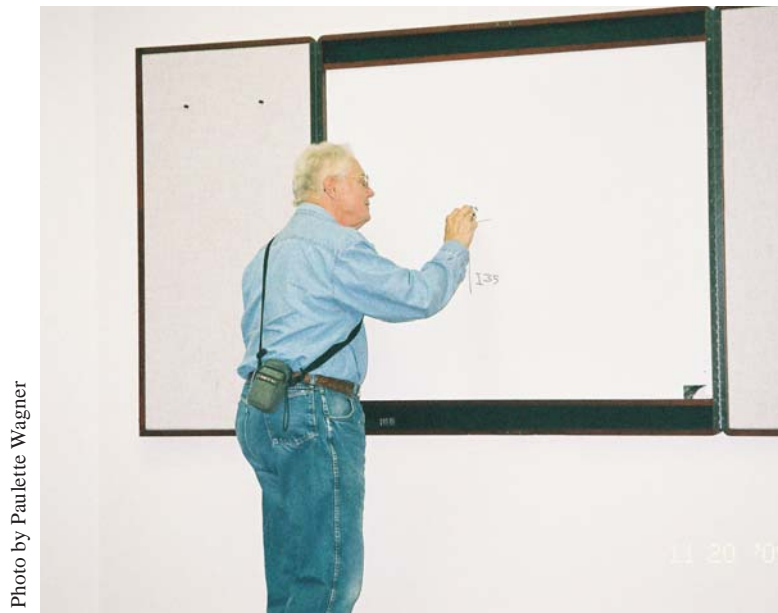

James & I recently attended the TEXAS MUSHROOM FESTIVAL held each year in Madisonville TX (about half way between Dallas & Houston), a typical small town event, that was well attended. It was a beautiful fall day that probably helped boost the attendance.

The Monterey Mushroom Co. in Madisonville produces over 600,000 pounds of mushroom per week and supplies about 4% of mushrooms in the US.

There were lots of vendors selling their wares including food (think State Fair), arts and crafts, etc. They also had a small car show -- No Corvettes.

The mushroom company's booth was cooking and serving portabella mushroom fajitas -- soooooo good. We got in line three times for our free mushroom fajitas! They were also selling four different kinds of fresh mushrooms. We purchased 2 bags of all four kinds; prices were one and two dollars for a pound of mushrooms. (Cheap)

One of the highlights of the event was held in a large tent. You paid \$10.00 to go in and see chefs from nearby towns prepare some of their specialties. (Samples were passed around when the chefs finished cooking -- Tasty!) There were also 16 wineries represented there. The ten dollars you paid also got you 2 wine glasses and ten tickets you used at the booths to taste their wines. Some very good -- Some not so good.

This is something that can be done in a day and we would recommend it. It is held each year in October.
